IMMUNISATIONS YEAR 8 & 10

Ozcare is providing free vaccinations for all Year 8
and Year 10 students as part of Queensland
Health's annual School Based Vaccination Program.

Year 8 students are being offered vaccination to protect against hepatitis B and
varicella (chickenpox). Year 10 students are being offered protection against
diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (whooping cough).

All students in Year 8, 2013 (Boys and Girls) are also being offered Human
Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination to protect against cervical cancer.

Students have to return their consent forms to receive immunisation on the following dates:

Plus any students requiring catch-up vaccinations.

Students who arrive on the day without prior consent will not be immunised.
