



GRANTS FOR ELITE STUDENT PERFORMANCE

Purpose

Grants for Elite Student Performance are designed to encourage all students to strive for excellence, to provide recognition for elite performance and to assist families by providing a financial benefit to support participation.

Scope

This Grant Program applies to all students of North Rockhampton State High School. Grants are for school based events and competitions which are sanctioned by the Department of Education and Training. The scope applies to Music and the Arts, Academic and Sporting achievement.

Eligibility & Limitations

The minimum requirement is that a student competes in a State level competition to be eligible to apply for a Grant. The eligibility must be endorsed by the School Principal (or delegate).

A student is eligible to receive only one grant per year relating to a specific achievement. A student is eligible to apply for more than one grant per year where the student is recognised for multiple achievements. Example:

- A student who represents the Capricornia District at a school based State Competition and then goes on to represent Queensland at a National competition is eligible to apply for individual grants for each achievement.
- A student who represents Capricornia for the same Sport at two carnivals in the same calendar year will only be eligible for one grant

Nb: To be eligible for P&C Association subsidy support, students must satisfy the criteria of the school's Special Events Policy in relation to the payment of Resource Hire Scheme fees and other school costs.

Value of Grants

The P&C reserve the right to vary the grants provided to students. The nominal value of grants will be \$150 for District Representation/or where competing in a State Competition, \$500 for State Representation/or where competing in a National Competition, and \$1000 for National Representation. A subsidy of \$1000 per team is available to support transport costs for team sports.

Applying for Grants

Application for grants should be made in writing by the student's parent or legal guardian and must be endorsed by the school principal (or delegate).

Approval of Grants

Individual grants applications will be considered by the P&C at a general meeting. Approval of the grant application by the P&C is discretionary. All students are expected to conduct themselves appropriately when participating in a school based event.

Payment for Grants

Payment will usually be made after the student has participated in the event, however, the P&C reserve the right to vary this policy. Payment will normally be made by cheque to the grant applicant.

Duration of Grant Program

This grant program shall be active for the entire calendar year and is retrospectively applicable to all achievements in that calendar year. Grant applications must be received before 3pm on the student's last day of the school year.

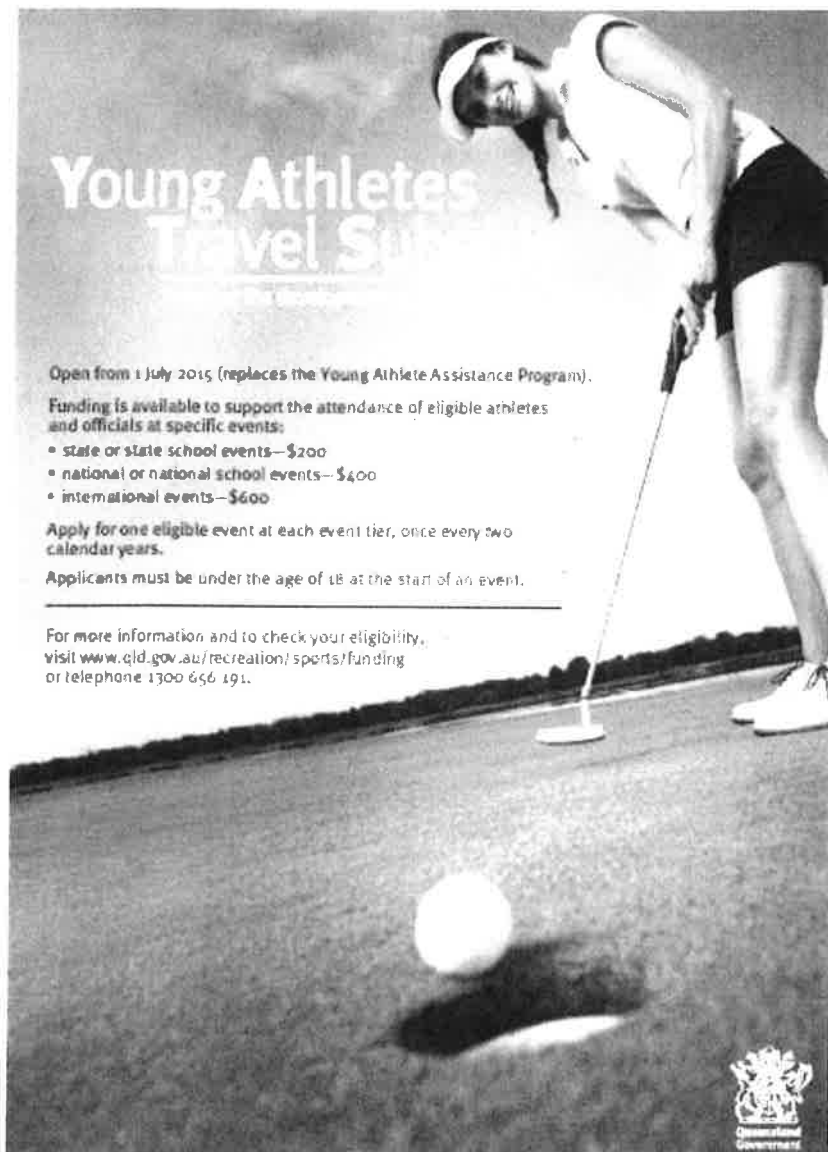

Young Athletes Travel Subsidy

Open from 1 July 2015 (replaces the Young Athlete Assistance Program).

Funding is available to support the attendance of eligible athletes and officials at specific events:

- state or state school events—\$200
- national or national school events—\$400
- international events—\$600

Apply for one eligible event at each event tier, once every two calendar years.

Applicants must be under the age of 18 at the start of an event.

Our P&C Association would also like to draw your attention to the Young Athletes' Travel Subsidy Program.

Young local athletes and officials who attend state, national and international championships are able to receive financial assistance under the revised Young Athletes Travel Subsidy program. The Subsidy will help cover the transport and accommodation costs involved with attending championship events.

Under the revised scheme, up to \$1200 can be provided every two years for both young athletes and officials.

There will now also be an allocation of funding to help cover the transportation and accommodation costs for each level of championship—\$200 for state, \$400 for national and \$600 for international.

Currently, young athletes and officials are eligible to receive \$200 every two years if they compete at a state, national or international championship event.

The government was committed to ensuring Queensland's young athletes were given every opportunity to achieve their full potential in the sporting arena.

With the 2018 Gold Coast Commonwealth Games just around the corner we need to get behind our young talented Queensland athletes and officials.

The Young Athletes Travel Subsidy would open for applications on 1 July 2015. For further information about an application or the new travel subsidy, contact the local Sport and Recreation Office on 1300 656 191.
